Trials locations will be in Hereford, Lubbock, Farwell, Roswell and New Mexico. Some overnight stays and weekend work may be required.

Supervision: You will be closely supervised but may be asked to carry out certain tasks that require you to travel alone. If you are asked to travel, a company vehicle will be provided.

Qualification: The ideal candidate will be a Junior or Senior from WTAM who is majoring in Agricultural Sciences, Agronomy, Ag-Business or a related field. Some prior knowledge of sorghum or corn production or experience working on a farm would be helpful, but not mandatory.
